

### Greetings from the Community Lay Director

Greeting each of you individually may not be possible but I can, through this message, greet you and wish each one of you God's love and blessing. As you have attended a Walk, I know that you have already received His wonderful love and blessing and I hope and pray that more is on the way.

There are lots of things happening at Minnesota Walk to Emmaus. I am new to the position of Community Lay Director and we will shortly be electing five new members to the Board of Directors. You may notice that this is the first Newsletter since early this year. We elected a Director to fill a vacancy on the Board, Craig Wilson, and he has agreed to head up communications for us. I am confident that newsletters will be coming on a regular basis in the near future and you will be hearing from several of us.

And we'd like to hear from you. We'd especially like to have you update your personal information in our database and hear your suggestions for improving Minnesota Walk to Emmaus. There is a form at the conclusion of this Newsletter. Please enter the requested information and e-mail it as indicated.

We have a set of Walks coming up shortly. The Men's Walk at Camp Koronis begins October 27 and the Women's Walk begins November 3. Please try to come to Candlelight and Closing on Oct. 29 at 8:00 P.M. and 4:30 P.M. on Oct 30 for the Men's Walk and on Nov. 5 at 8:00 P.M. and Nov. 6 at 4:30 P.M. for the Women's Walk. There will be an offering taken at Candlelight and your help with our financial situation would be much appreciated. Currently we have little to offer as scholarships and have no margin for any unforeseen expenses. I hope you will respond to this need. One of the improvements we hope to make in our communications is to include a financial report on the website periodically so that you will know how we are doing financially.

You may be surprised when you check the FUTURE WALK DATES and find a set of Walks in May being held in Clintonville, WI. We normally hold a set of Walks in January in Stewartville, MN but, for several reasons, we decided that we will not hold Walks there again this year. Then, we had some Pilgrims from Appleton, WI attend the Walks this past summer in Grantsburg.

They are attempting to start an Emmaus Community there and have been going to Georgia to attend Walks. They want a set of Walks in their area and, as we had cancelled a set, we agreed to hold what is called an OUTREACH WALK. The team will be a joint effort and we will share in the excitement of helping to establish a new Emmaus community!

And please check the schedule of Walks for another reason. One of the things we need to emphasize is the need for all of us to SPONSOR PILGRIMS. We are the only ones that can get others to experience God's love and blessing that comes from attending a Walk. With our approximately 1600 members, we have the capability of conducting many, many more Walks than we have been doing. But, we have not filled several of the ones that have been held.

- ☐ write the names of five people that you believe would benefit by attending a Walk. The next thing to do is to pray about it.
- ☐ Then, when the Spirit tells you it is time, talk to them – tell them about the Walk – what it did for you – what the 72 hours are like – be open and honest. Your experience told to others is probably the best, most convincing story.

I believe God has called us – you and I - to work for Him in Minnesota Walk to Emmaus. There is an enormous opportunity for us to serve God in this work. We, and the others like us, are the only ones we have to RECRUIT and SPONSOR PILGRIMS.

My prayer is that our Walks will be filled to overflowing and we'll need to have more and more Walks. Please help achieve this!

## REUNION GROUP vs. GATHERING

How does a reunion group differ from a gathering? The Emmaus reunion group is a small accountability group of two to six people who have usually, but not always, participated in the three-day Walk to Emmaus, and who have a desire to continue their pursuit of a life lived wholly in the grace of God. These small follow-up groups help pilgrims translate the message conveyed on the weekend into a daily walk with Christ, through the disciplines of piety, study and action. Reunion groups have a common purpose, that is, to help us persevere in grace. The groups meet at regular times, usually weekly for an hour. The meeting consists of people sharing the stories of their walk with Christ during the past week, in the pattern provided by the service card. Group members listen to one another, celebrate the grace of God in each person's life, and reinforce each one's commitment to living in union with Christ in all facets of daily life. The group provides support, encouragement, and accountability, and may also

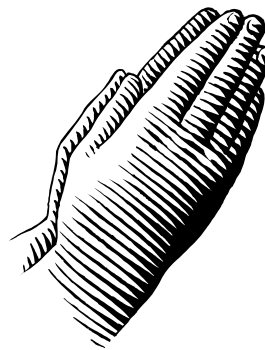
## REUNION GROUPS
